ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2019-12-18

The statute, 705 ILCS 405/5-805(3), states: "If a petition alleges commission by a minor *13 years of age or over* of an act that constitutes a *crime* under the laws of this State, and on motion of the State's Attorney to permit prosecution of the minor under the criminal laws, a Juvenile Judge assigned by the Chief Judge of the Circuit to hear and determine those motions, *after hearing*, but before commencement of the trial, *finds* that there is *probable cause* to believe that the *allegations in the motion are true* and that *it is not in the best interests of the public* to proceed under this Act, the court may enter an order permitting prosecution under the criminal laws." (Emphasis added)
