- Any form that is an "Easy Form" is actually a "form program." This means that you will be asked a series of questions and the program will create the forms for you.

- It is much easier to fill out an Easy Form than it is to fill out a paper form.
- Using an Easy Form means that you are more likely to fill them out correctly, which is important when you are going to court.
