Except as set forth and permitted by Supreme Court Rule, the use of cameras, television or other recording or broadcast equipment is prohibited in a courtroom, in the immediate vicinity of a courtroom, and in the chambers and offices of the court, without the express, advance, written permission of the presiding judge of the county.


The presiding judge shall prescribe the conditions, guidelines, and specific rules under which such equipment shall be used.

If a violation of this administrative order has occurred, the presiding judge shall notify the offender to immediately cease and desist such activity and order delivery of the recording(s) to the court. If an offending party refuses to comply with the directives of the presiding judge, the presiding judge may act to end such activity, including the seizure of the prohibited equipment, and the party may be subject to contempt of court proceedings.

This order is effective upon entry and shall remain in effect until further order of this Court.
